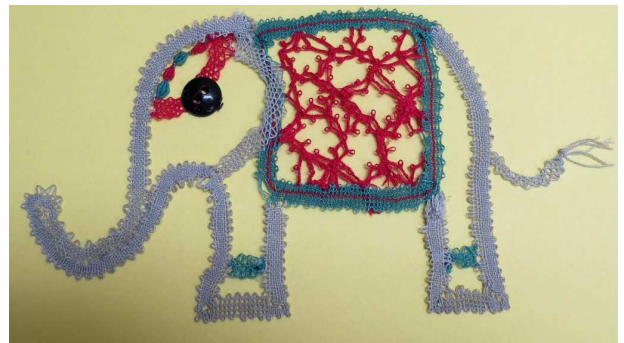


1st Place - Kate Wild
