Beginning Bobbin Lace: Instruction in the basic stitches used in Bobbin Lace. Supplies for use in the class will be provided by the guild.

Bobbin Lace Part 2: Taking the next steps in Lacemaking. There are plenty of manuals and videos that provide tips and techniques in bobbin lace. But, at times, it's a lot easier if you take those steps with a person guiding your way. Members of the LACE guild have put together a series of topics and techniques, including: reading a pattern, different starts and finishes, adding bobbins, throwing bobbins out, broken threads, corners, and turns, etc.

Class participants should have basic knowledge of the basic stitches of bobbin lace. Prickings will be provided for the teaching projects. Bring your pillow, bobbins and supplies. Thread requirements and the number of bobbins needed will be emailed to you prior to the class.

This class will meet both Friday and Saturday from 10 am to 4 pm. There will be a one hour lunch break. Bring your lunch or check out a nearby restaurant.
